Lines of development for the PRESIDENCY (2025–2027) Interamerican Society of Psychology

This document briefly describes the work plan of Dr. Gonzalo Salas, candidate for the presidency of the Interamerican Society of Psychology (ISP).

Line 1. Institutional Strengthening

- Promote the development of an Institutional Strategic Plan (2025–2031) of the ISP, renewable every six years.
- Strengthen the institutional framework and the ISP's links with other organizations such as colleges of psychologists and scientific associations of psychology.
- Strengthen the organization and dissemination of the working groups (WG).
- Strengthen the national representations of the ISP.
- Significantly increase ISP membership in countries with low development and strengthen membership in countries with a longer tradition.

Line 2. Training in Psychology

- To discuss and promote standards in psychology training at different levels (undergraduate, master's, and doctorate).
- To update ethical and deontological issues in psychology at the different levels of training.
- To analyze training in psychology in relation to the requirements and needs of 21st century society.

Line 3. Governance

- Prioritize the gender agenda of the ISP, in order to reduce the existing gaps in the science and profession of psychology that are detrimental to the work of women.
- To give priority to psychological work with vulnerable groups in the Americas.
- Contribute to public debate and decision-making on social issues such as poverty reduction, social injustice and inequalities.
- To give greater visibility to the ISP in the Americas.

Line 4. Research and Dissemination of Science

- Promote research networks in psychology in the Americas.
- To advance in the challenges of the Interamerican Journal of Psychology, Bulletin and Editorial Seal of the ISP.
- To promote the dissemination of psychological science to the community in general.
